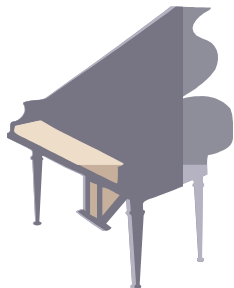


## Studio Policy for Piano and Clarinet Lessons

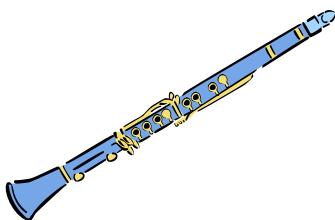
**LESSON SIGN UP** - Lessons would begin after the Orientation, which is a 15 minute meet and greet for the teacher and student to get to know each other. Students would then be required to sign up in advance for the month. Students have one lesson per week. Payments for individual lessons are not accepted.

**PAYMENTS** - If payment in cash is not received before the 1st of the month the instructor will not give a lesson.

**NO MAKE-UP LESSONS** – Since the enrollment is scheduled on a monthly basis there are no make-ups for other than illness or emergencies.

**PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT** – If your child is 5 years old, parents are required to sit in on the lesson with their child. Students in private lessons that are 6 years old and above are not required to have their parents stay with them at their lesson. However, parents are required to make sure their child is practicing the appropriate amount of time and are prepared for their lesson.

**PLEASE BE ON TIME FOR YOUR LESSON** - students who arrive late to their lesson are not given extra time.
